Article I. Name

Cortland County Microd Association, D/B/A
Mid-State Microd Club (MMC)

Article II. Purpose

Mid-State Microd Club is a youth oriented racing organization that seeks to promote Sportsmanship and family values through racing.

Article III. Membership

Membership is open to all interested parties. A nominal fee will be assessed in order to maintain the financial viability of the organization. Memberships may be revoked by the Board of Directors for cause. See addendum for current fee structure.

Article IV. Leadership

The Board of Directors is the governing body of the club, and has the power to make rules and regulations for the club. The Board of Directors consists of the elected positions.

Section 4.01 Officers/Directors

- a. Elected: President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary
- b. Elected: Minimum of three & one alternate

Section 4.02 Appointed Officials

- a. Competition: Tech Inspector, Race Director, Pit Steward, Head Scorer, Flagger(s)
- b. Operations: Concession Stand Manager, Property Steward, Announcer, Classics Manager

Article V. Meeting Schedule

- a. Board of Directors and Officers shall hold regular monthly meetings.
- b. Special meetings shall be held at the declaration of the President
- c. All members are welcome and encouraged to attend the regular Board of Directors meetings.

Article VI. Amendments

Section 6.01 Amending the Constitution

- a. The constitution may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all the Directors, following the procedures outline in Article of the By-Laws.
